- 1888 Bethesda Baptist Church organized
- 1889 Bethesda calls first pastor, Rev. Henry Cremer
- 1890 Southern New York Baptist Association met and accepted Bethesda as a regular church. Attending were delegates from Abyssinian Baptist Church, NYC; Mt. Olivet Baptist Church, NYC; Concord Baptist Church, Brooklyn, NY; Messiah Baptist Church, Brooklyn, NY; Bethel Baptist Church, White Plains; and Shiloh Baptist Church, Jersey City, NJ.
- 1890 Bethesda Baptist Church legally incorporated in the State of New York.
- 1907 Rev. J. B. Boddie called as pastor.
- 1917 Rev. J. B. Boddie organized the Mission Society.
- 1917 Church moved into new building on Lincoln Avenue
- 1923 Joint Usher Board organized.
- 1927 Mortgage on church property burned.
- 1930 Bethesda hires Professor and Mrs. Bertram F. Minton as Ministers of Music.
- 1932 Senior Choir organized
- 1937 Rev. J. Raymond Henderson called as pastor
- 1938 Hostess Group organized by Rev. J. Raymond Henderson
- 1942 Jr. Usher Board organized
- 1961 Rev. Dr. Clarence M. Long, Sr. Called as Pastor
- 1961 Church destroyed in fire
- 1969 Rev. Roy L. Thompson called as pastor
- 1973 Bethesda burns mortgage - "Debt Free in 73"
- 1980 Rev. Allen Paul Weaver, Jr. called as pastor.
- 1982 Purchased property on the corner of Brook Street and Lincoln Avenue
- 1984 Organized the Lad's Lunch Ministry to feed the hungry within our community
- 1985 Capital improvements in the sanctuary: new sound system, lights, carpeting, and pews
- 1988 100th Church Anniversary - Theme: Serving God and Mankind Faithfully in Turbulent Times.
- 1991 Bethesda sends first missionary to Zaire, Africa - Anthony Cherry
- 1993 First female preacher ordained - Rev. Tamara Potter.
- 1995 Bethesda Ordained first female deacons: Rosetta Brown, Barbara Dillard, Rethella M. Lewis, Marjorie Osinloye, Mary Parker, Rosetta Peterman, Rosa Pulley, Paula Russell, Eugenie VanWhervin, and Nettie J. Weaver
- 1998 Constitution and By-Laws adopted
- 2000 Purchased buildings 57-59 Lincoln Avenue for \$250,000
- 2004 ElderCare Ministry organized
- 2008 Ribbon Cutting and Dedication of Family Life Center
- 2010 First Graduates' Banquet
- 2010 Pastor Weaver's 30th Anniversary

BLACK HISTORY MONTH

The story of African Americans in the United States is one of both immeasurable suffering and soaring hope. Two and a half centuries of slavery and segregation prevented black men and women from exercising the rights of citizenship taken for granted by their white counterparts.

African Americans who fought for freedom from tyranny abroad, helping to liberate Europe from Nazi Germany in World War II, for example, returned to the United States and were denied the right to register to vote—and some were beaten or killed while attempting to do so. In much of the country, blacks were forbidden to share the same spaces—including schools, public transportation, and recreational facilities—as whites. And measures were taken to prohibit African Americans from living near whites. Nevertheless, African Americans persevered, building universities and achieving heights in all spheres of activity, from arts and entertainment to aviation and science.

It was just over a century ago, in 1909, that the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) was formed with the aim of abolishing segregation and discrimination in housing, education, employment, voting, and transportation and securing for African Americans their constitutional rights. The struggle for freedom was long and difficult and included, among other tactics, litigation, marches, and sit-ins. It was also almost universally nonviolent, a reflection of the spirit of the leader who came to personify the American civil rights movement, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

Recent years have been momentous ones in the history of the United States and African Americans,

years marking major anniversaries of the civil rights movement and the realization of those dreams at the highest level, with Barack Obama's election as the first African American president. On April 4, 2008, the United States observed the 40th anniversary of the assassination of Dr. King. On August 28, 2008, precisely 45 years after Dr. King gave his famous I Have a Dream speech at the March on Washington, Barack Obama accepted the Democratic nomination for the presidency of the United States, becoming the first African American to be nominated by a major U.S. party.

January 15, 2009, marked the 80th anniversary of Dr. King's birth. Five days later, on January 20, Americans celebrated one hard-won step in the fulfillment of his dream: Barack Obama's inauguration as the 44th president of the United States.

Indeed, this event signaled the start of a new era in the civil rights movement, one in which all children can imagine the freedom to excel at anything and the possibility of being judged, to echo Dr. King, by the content of their character rather than the colour of their skin.

The struggles of the civil rights movement were further remembered on February 1, 2010, which marked the 50th anniversary of the Greensboro sit-in.
